Learning focus

In the Nursery we have noticed the tamariki have been really engaging with sensory exploration. We have been very busy investigating sand and water, paint and play dough. Recognising this interest, we have recently set our group focus on sensory exploration and have lots of fun messy experiences planned. Language and literacy are a part of our daily curriculum with many books being read each day. Search and find books are very popular at the moment. Our new bus pop up tent has also been a big hit!







Tamariki in the Pukeko room have been thoroughly enjoying the new sandpit area! With the sandpit renovations complete, there has been much joy in having this experience back in the outdoor environment. There has been a lot of social interaction happening as the tamariki work together on their creations and let their imaginations run wild. The hut beside the sandpit has also been a hive of activity with tamariki using it for many different dramatic play scenarios such as ice cream shops, bakeries and much more! This is giving the tamariki a great opportunity to develop and refine their social skills as they work closely alongside each other.

We have also been fortunate enough to get two weighted blankets for the preschool tamariki. Weighted blankets can be calming for tamariki who are feeling heightened in their emotions whether they are anxious, frustrated, angry etc. Tamariki have been exploring these blankets in quiet spaces alongside kaiako, often enjoying listening to stories while they are snuggled. Tamariki are beginning to requested the use of the blankets which is means they are noticing how they are feeling and able to recognise when they are needing to calm down or have some quiet time which is an amazing self regulation skill to have.
